

Website privacy and cookie policy for http://www.vipaspa.it/ in accordance with art. 13 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679

With the current privacy notice, the Data Controller provides the information regarding methods and purposes of personal data processing of users who visit the website https://www.vipaspa.it. This privacy notice informs you on the rights you can assert as established by EU Regulation n. 2016/679 and it could be subject to changes and updates, as well as complemented by special privacy notices if any other service requested by the user implied different processing of personal data.

1) Data Controller

The Data Controller is VIPA S.p.A. (P.I. e C.F.: 00007080369) with registered office in Carpi (MO), Via Abetone n. 20, and head office in Rolo (RE), Via Cantonazzo n. 20/22 (email: info@vipaspa.it – pec: pec@pec.vipaspa.it). 2) Categories of personal data collected

The collection and processing, preceded by the granting of consent where required, concerns the following types of data:

- **I Identification and common personal data**: in order to manage the relationship with the user and/or the related services, personal data are collected including, but not limited to, user identification data such as name, surname, location, e-mail address e all necessary information for providing properly the services requested.
- II Special categories of personal data: this website currently does not collect and process special categories of personal data. If their collection and processing should prove necessary, we will ask you to give your consent, according to art. 9 of EU Regulation n. 2016/679.
- III Data acquired during you web browsing session: the website's operation involves the use of computer system and software procedures, which collect information about the website's users as part of their routine operation, whose transmission is automatic when using internet communication protocols. Although the Data Controller does not collect this information to associate it to specific users, it is still possible that, by its nature and through processing and association with further data held by third parties, such information may permit to identify users. These data includes your IP address, the domain names of your computer, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of resources you request on this website, the time of requests made, the method used to submit requests to the server, the dimension of the file obtained in response to a request, the numerical code indicating the status of the response sent by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters related to the user's operating system and IT environment. The Data Controller shall only use such data for anonymous, statistical purposes about the use of the website and to ensure its correct operation. This data may also be used for the purposes of investigating liabilities in the event of information crimes.
- **IV Cookies**: cookies are small text files that are stored in your device (PC, tablet, smartphone) when visiting our website and allow it to recognise the browser on future visits. The Data Controller use cookies mainly to give you the best experience on our website, storing information the system can use later again, such as the information





which are requested to log in to the reserved area.

Our system uses time-limited session cookies, which are automatically erased when you close your browser and persistent cookies, which remain on your device until they expire or are erased by the user himself.

Which cookies does this website use?

This website uses the following cookies:

- 1. Technical and session cookies: they are temporary and give the user access to personalized features; these cookies enable us to enhance tour-browsing experience on this website.
- 2. Analytical cookies: both temporary and permanent, they are used for aggregate collection of information about the behaviour of users on the website and thus improve the experience and content provided.
- 3. Social media cookies: are provided directly from the social media domains we host through links to official pages, share buttons and links. 3) Purposes of personal data processing

Personal data you provide us are processed for the following purposes:

- iii) To send newsletters and dedicated offers, prior explicit consent of the data subject;
- iv) To give general information regarding other goods and services offered, similar to those already purchased or accessed and pursuant to art. 130, c. 4, of Italian Privacy Code;
- V) To obtain necessary information to browse this website and statistical information on the use of services to improve the user experience and monitor the use of this website.

4) Methods of personal data processing

The personal data processing is performed by means of operations indicated in art. 4 of the EU Regulation n. 2016/679. The following activities are identified as processing of personal data: registration, organization, conservation, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, block, communication, dissemination, erasure, destruction.

Personal data collected are processed by manual elaboration and telematic form.

The Data Controller shall process personal data only as long as is strictly necessary and shall use the information collected exclusively for the purposes mentioned above and at the latest 10 years after the termination of the relationship for the purposes set out in art. 4, notwithstanding different time limit as established for the compliance with law and tax obligations.

Your personal data will be stored within the European Union and the related security policies are reviewed according to the best practices in relation to data protection.

No profiling activities or other automated decision-making processes are used on this website.

5) Nature of data provision

The provision of personal data is generally not mandatory; anyway, sometimes it can be necessary to enable the user to receive the services requested and fully benefit from the functions the website provides.

The provision of personal data is necessary for the purposes under point 4, n. i) and ii). No consent is required for





the processing of data for the purposes described above and, therefore, for the performance of an agreement to which you are a party ore the implementation of measures requested prior to entering into an agreement. It is not mandatory for the user to give the Data Controller its personal data for these purposes; however, if you do not provide us your personal data, the Data Controller will not be able to provide any services to you.

6) Legal basis of the processing

Under the existing EU Regulation, personal data are processed in accordance with the following legal basis:

- i) The fulfilment of any pre-contractual, contractual, tax and legal obligations arising from the relationship with the data subject, with regard the purposes in art. 4, par. i);
- ii) The consent given in a specifically and correctly way, unambiguous and clear, with regard the purposes in art. 4, par. ii) and iii);
- iii) The legitimate interest of the Data Controller with regard the purposes in art. 4, par. iv) and v).

7) Recipients or categories of recipients

Personal data may be disclosed and processed only by the following subjects:

- i) Employees and collaborators of the Data Controller, as designated and authorized by the Data Controller, on the basis of their skills, assigned tasks and given instructions;
- ii) Data processors ex art. 28 of the EU Regulations specifically appointed such as their authorized employees and collaborators, because of their skills, assigned tasks and given instructions.

8) Data transfer to third countries

The Data Controller does not transfer personal data to third countries. However, it can happen servers of third parties, as service providers, are physically located in foreign countries. In that case, the data transfer to third countries will take place in compliance with the EU Regulation n. 2016/679, art. 44 et sq.

9) Rights of the data subject

In accordance to art. 15 et sq, EU Regulation n. 2016/679, you have the right, at any time, to obtain from the Data Controller access to your personal data, receive a copy of the personal data processed, modify them and erase them, limit the processing and oppose data processing based on legitimate interest;

You have also the right to withdraw your consent: if the processing is based on consent, data subjects have the right to withdraw it at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given prior to its withdrawal. You can exercise the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority "Garante per la protezione dei dati personali" (https://www.garanteprivacy.it/web/guest).

To object to data processing and to exercise other rights, you can write to the Controller to the address info@vipaspa.it or to the addresses given in art. 2 of this privacy notice. To handle the request, the Data Controller reserves the right to ask the exhibition of a valid ID card.

The Data Controller reserves the right to partly or fully amend this privacy policy, or simply to update its content, e.g., because of changes in applicable law.
